**Solar Trade Allies and Other Interested Parties,**

We are providing additional details on a multi-site incentive rate available, subject to funding, during 2008 in the PGE service territory.

When one commercial or nonprofit/government entity will install multiple systems at multiple sites, Energy Trust will look at that entity's sites on a cumulative basis and will aggregate the total capacity of all of the proposed systems to determine eligibility for the multi-site incentive rate which will apply for each individual system. If the aggregated installed capacity is 180kW or greater then the entity may apply for the multi-site incentive rate.

Examples of nonprofit and government entities were described in our 2/25/08 announcement. A commercial example would be if there were multiple sites owned or controlled by a single company, holding company, or through franchise or lease arrangements.

**Eligibility**

- Available only to commercial, government and non-profit customers of Portland General Electric (PGE).
- Available only for systems that will be installed by December 31, 2008.
- If an entity is seeking a custom incentive rate<sup>1</sup>, it may not apply for the multi-site incentive.
- Final determination of an entity's eligibility for the multi-site incentive rate rests solely with Energy Trust.

**Incentive Information**

- If an entity has two or more systems totaling more than 180 kW of aggregated installed capacity, the entity may apply for the multi-site incentive of \$0.80 per watt.
- If an entity has aggregated installed capacity totaling 180 kW or less, that entity will not be eligible to apply for the multi-site incentive rate and may apply for the standard commercial incentive rate, subject to the program requirements for that offer.
- If an entity has any individual site with a capacity greater than 300 kW, Energy Trust will cap the amount of capacity for that individual site at 300 kW for the purposes of calculating the total aggregated capacity for the multi-site incentive.
- An entity applying for the multi-site incentive may not apply to Energy Trust for any other solar electric incentive funding during 2008. The maximum multi-site incentive amount available to a single entity will be \$800,000 for systems completed in 2008, subject to the reservation limit.
- Energy Trust has set aside a pool of \$1.6 million for approved multi-site incentive applications, and will provide updates as funding is reserved.

### Timing

- If an entity is applying for the multi-site incentive rate for its systems, those systems must be installed in 2008. Energy Trust will require, during the reservation time period, demonstration of progress towards timely completion or the reservation may be withdrawn.

### Application Process and Reservation Limit

- Applicants for the multi-site incentive must submit individual applications (i.e. a **Form 220C** or **Form 220T**, as applicable) for each system along with a cover letter describing the overall aggregated installed capacity of the combined systems. The applicant will not be able to use the incentive calculator on the forms, but will be prompted to contact Energy Trust. The cover letter must list each site address, installed capacity and expected per-year generation for each project and identify if more than one trade ally will install the systems.
- Each application under this offer will be treated as a separate application for the purpose of Energy Trust's 12 active reservation limit.

Energy Trust may further adjust the solar electric incentive program due to volatility of the market, changes in other incentives, and a finite budget.
