- Insulation levels in the attic, walls, floors and ducts
- Heating system
- Air leaks and windows
- Ventilation
- Moisture problems

Your energy advisor will also give you the information you need to make your home more comfortable—while using less energy—and provide free instant energy-saving products.

Make energy-saving home improvements

With your advisor's recommendations, you'll have all the information to make improvements. When you're ready to install energy-efficiency upgrades, contact an Energy Trust trade ally contractor—or any other contractor with an Oregon Construction Contractors Board license, or a current Washington contractor's license—to discuss and schedule your project.* Washington customers heating their home with gas from NW Natural are eligible to participate.
