



# RECEIVE A FREE TURBO POT

WITH YOUR PURCHASE OF QUALIFYING ENERGY EFFICIENT FOODSERVICE EQUIPMENT

Speed up cooking time and save energy! Turbo Pots are designed with an aluminum heat sink on the bottom to provide efficient and uniform heating. Made of high-quality stainless steel, the Turbo Pot is estimated to cut heating time by approximately 50 percent compared to standard pots.

If you are an eligible commercial foodservice operation applying for an Energy Trust incentive towards the purchase of an item of qualifying foodservice equipment,\* you can also apply to receive a free 22-quart Turbo Pot, with an estimated retail value of \$250, from Energy Trust while supplies last. Additional requirements and details to apply are listed on the reverse side of this flyer.

In order to be eligible to participate in this limited time promotion, you must be a qualifying commercial foodservice operation that is either **(i)** located in Oregon and using a natural gas-fired range and served by either NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas, or **(ii)** located in Washington and using a natural-gas fired range and served by NW Natural.

## To apply for a Turbo Pot you must:

- 1** Be a commercial foodservice operation, that uses a natural gas-fired range, located in **(i)** Oregon and served by NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas, or **(ii)** Washington and served by NW Natural. Determination of eligibility rests with Energy Trust.
- 2** Purchase at least one item of qualifying energy-efficient foodservice equipment that meets Energy Trust specifications listed on *Oregon Program Information Sheet 194F* and *Washington Program Information Sheet 193WA*.

  - The signed *Form 120P Standard Incentive Application* to request Energy Trust incentives for your purchased foodservice equipment, along with all the required accompanying documentation specified in the application.
  - A copy of this Turbo Pot Application, completed and signed below.
  - A completed IRS Form W-9 or Energy Trust substitute W-9 available from [www.energytrust.org](http://www.energytrust.org).
  - A copy of your NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas bill.

Only complete applications will be processed, so be sure that you include all required documentation to avoid delays.

This promotion is limited to one free Turbo Pot per Participant site address. Supplies are limited and requests for Turbo Pots will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Once supplies are exhausted, this promotion will end.

Supplies of Turbo Pots are limited, and will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Once supplies are exhausted, this offer will end.

**Manufacturer information:** Turbo Pot is a product of Eneron, Inc. Participant should follow manufacturer directions for use and operation of the Turbo Pot and should contact the manufacturer directly if there are any defects or other problems. Among other things, Turbo Pot is not for use on electric ranges and may scratch cook top or other surfaces. Turbo Pot is a product of Eneron, Inc. and may be shipped to Participants in its original packaging.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for this promotion, the named Participant must be a commercial foodservice operation that uses a natural gas-fired range, and **(i)** located in Oregon and served by either NW Natural Gas or Cascade Natural Gas or **(ii)** located in Washington and served by NW Natural Gas. In addition, the Participant must be purchasing and applying for incentives, via a submitted Form 120P, for qualifying energy-efficient foodservice equipment that meets Energy Trust's program specifications. Only one Turbo Pot can ever be redeemed per eligible Participant site address. This promotion cannot be combined with any other Turbo Pot promotion that Energy Trust may offer. Final determination of eligibility rests solely with Energy Trust.

**Use Agreement and Evaluation:** Participant agrees **(i)** that it will use the Turbo Pot at Participant's site address as listed on NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas bill only, and the Turbo Pot shall not be re-sold or re-purposed or re-gifted, and **(ii)** that Energy Trust may contact Participant to discuss the Turbo Pot to evaluate Participant's satisfaction and its energy efficiency.
