**Portland Energy Conservation, Inc. is a Program Management Contractor for Energy Trust of Oregon.**

This offer is valid for residential ENERGY STAR® clothes washers with a Modified Energy Factor of 2.46 or higher<sup>i</sup>, residential ENERGY STAR refrigerators that are at least 30 percent above federal standards, and ENERGY STAR freezers that are at least 10 percent above federal standards installed in Oregon. To qualify for the clothes washer incentive, participants with an electric water heater must be customers of Portland General Electric or Pacific Power and participants with a gas water heater must be customers of NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas. Refrigerator and freezer incentives are available to customers of Portland General Electric and Pacific Power. Incentive offer is subject to funding availability and may change.

**How to get your Energy Trust incentive:**

- ❶ Purchase a qualifying residential clothes washer, refrigerator or freezer between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012.
- ❷ For faster processing, complete your application online at [www.energytrust.org/appliances](http://www.energytrust.org/appliances) OR complete and sign this incentive application. Submit the application as soon as possible to secure your incentive. Application must be received by March 31, 2013.
- ❸ Mail the incentive application, and **a copy of the itemized sales receipt**, to:

**ELIGIBILITY:** Incentives are available to Oregon customers of Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural and Cascade Natural Gas. Customers who are commercial businesses or landlords must send in a completed W-9 to receive an incentive.

Customers who have already received an Energy Trust incentive at time of purchase, are not eligible for an additional incentive on that appliance.

**Clothes Washers:** Clothes washers must be ENERGY STAR® certified and have an MEF of 2.46 or higher to be eligible. Participants must be residential customers that heat their water with fuel from Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas. Energy Trust will refer to the Qualified Models list posted on their website when approving applications.

**Refrigerators and Freezers:** Refrigerators must be ENERGY STAR certified and be at least 30 percent above federal standards to qualify. Freezers must be ENERGY STAR certified to be eligible. Refrigerators or freezers must be installed in an Oregon residence within Portland General Electric or Pacific Power service territory. Energy Trust will refer to the Qualified Models list posted on their website when approving applications.

All applicants must submit a sales receipt showing that the appliance was purchased between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012, and reflect the purchase of a *new* appliance. The following list includes, but is not limited to, purchases that are not eligible:

- Resale, used or refurbished appliances.
- Leased or rented appliances.
- Appliances received due to a warranty claim, recall or exchange.
- Appliances won as a prize or given as a gift.

Incentive offers are subject to funding availability and may change. Regardless of the date of purchase, no incentive applications for purchases made in 2012 will be accepted after March 31, 2013. Neither Energy Trust nor Portland Energy Conservation, Inc. shall be responsible for lost or misdirected mail.
