Multiple Measure Incentive Packages

Windows Bonus
Install windows with a 2nd qualifying measure*** and participant receive a \$100 bonus in addition to Energy Trust incentives.

*** Qualifying measures include floor insulation, or qualifying high-efficiency gas tank water heater, or high efficiency electric tank water heater. Second qualifying improvement for the windows incentive must be installed within 90 days of window installation.

<p>Rules for Self-Installed Upgrades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electric water heaters and floor insulation are the only measures that can be installed by a homeowner. • Participant must receive pre-approval by calling 1.866.311.1822 before starting work. • Incentives are only paid for materials, not labor. • For self-installed electric water heaters, participant must provide proof of a city permit and city inspection with the incentive application. • Homeowner-completed projects will be subjected to Quality Control inspections by Energy Trust to verify that upgrades have been properly installed. 	<p>Important Existing Homes Program Terms and Conditions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homes must be pre-qualified in order to receive the free air and duct sealing incentives. • Only approved Existing Mobile Home trade allies may install, apply for and receive incentives for Existing Mobile Home program 'no cost to participant' measures (page 1). • Forms must be submitted within 90 days from initial installation. • Forms must be complete, accurate and include all required documentation for incentives to be paid. • Energy Trust reserves the right to modify measure incentives and financing during the program period.
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
