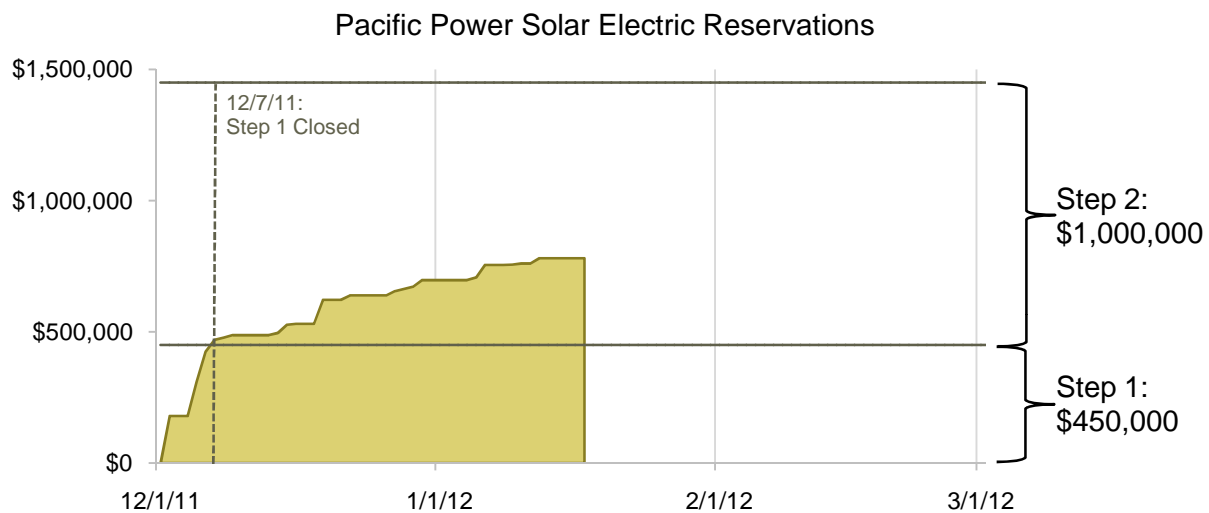


## Energy Trust of Oregon Solar Electric Program Pacific Power Incentives Status Report

The Energy Trust solar electric incentives for Pacific Power territory have become constrained due to high demand and limited new funding in 2012. The budget for Pacific Power projects will be managed in steps with decreasing incentive levels to help ensure continuous funding remains available. The table and chart below represent the current funding availability and incentive levels.
