During the Reservation Period, if you or your Trade Ally decide to make any additional changes to the System, then you will be required to re-submit an updated, signed application to the Small Wind Program *before* making any changes to the System, and the updated application must go through our review and approval process to determine whether the revised System is still eligible for our incentives.

Because Energy Trust has limited incentive funding, Energy Trust may require demonstration of progress towards project completion during the Reservation Period. If we determine that appropriate progress is not being made to complete timely installation, the reserved incentive funds may be withdrawn. Please review the terms and conditions of our **Form 720X** for details. If you decide to cancel the project at any point during the Reservation Period, please notify us immediately.
