ELIGIBILITY: The ductless heat pump, ducted heat pump, attic insulation, wall insulation, and floor insulation incentives listed in this application are available to eligible Customers who are: (i) Oregon residential electric service customers of Pacific Power within the territory displayed on page 6 of this application. (ii) Incentives for energy-saving measures that help save on the cost of water heating are available to customers who primarily heat their water with electricity provided by Portland General Electric or Pacific Power or natural gas provide by NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista. (iii) Incentives for energy-saving measures that help save on the cost of home heating not listed in section (i) are available to customers who primarily heat their home with electricity provided by Portland General Electric or Pacific Power and customers who primarily heat their home with natural gas provided by NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista.
