Training attendees will be eligible for full reimbursement from Energy Trust for **one** successfully completed training course.

Building Automation Fundamentals

Provides foundational knowledge including the general components, processes and technologies of modern BAS

Building Automation Operations Management

Provides greater depth to BAS topics including understanding user interfaces, creating maintenance schedules and managing energy use

Provides a comprehensive study of HVAC control sequences

ELIGIBILITY

- Employer organization is enrolled in commercial SEM at the time of incentive request
- Individual completing the course must be a staff member regularly working in a building that is currently enrolled in SEM

AND

 Individual has already completed <u>Building Operator</u> <u>Certification (BOC)</u> Level 1 training

OR

 Individual has three or more years of experience working in building operations and maintenance of a commercial or institutional facility

INCENTIVE REQUIREMENTS

- Complete the BAS Training Course <u>intake form</u>. The intake form should be submitted by the individual taking the course
- Complete the selected training course and pass the final course exam
- Complete one of the five eligible BAS activities included in the Eligible Activities worksheet provided by your energy coach:
 - 1. Supply fan trend
 - 2. Morning warm-up trend
 - 3. Night Low Limit (NLL) operation trend
 - 4. Calculate percent outside air
 - 5. Identify hot water valve leak-by
- Submit all required documents to your energy coach by the incentive form due date to receive reimbursement. The following documentation will be required:
 - o Certificate of completion (provided by SBA)
 - o Documentation showing completion of one eligible BAS activity
 - o Energy Trust Form 104SEM-BAS
- Complete a <u>post-training survey</u> to provide Energy Trust with feedback on your experience
