Custom Projects

Energy-efficiency equipment not covered by standard incentives may still be eligible for custom incentives. Cash incentives for qualified custom energy projects are calculated based on estimated annual energy savings. Controls, chillers, variable frequency drives, and retro-commissioning are a few examples.




