- 3. This is a new requirement. There is no incumbent contractor.
- 4. It is desirable, but not required, that contractors are certified by Oregon or SBA. No additional evidence of certification is required for submission.
- 5. Information regarding timeline, phases, platforms, and technical information will be provided later in the process for the selected contractors. There is no specific deadline for projects at this time.
- 6. A "direct or indirect conflict" is defined as any situation in which an individual or member of their family or close business or personal acquaintance, is employed by Energy Trust or the Oregon Public Utility Commission, or may be reasonably construed to have a direct or indirect personal or financial interest in any business affairs of Energy Trust.
